ARTIST CONTRACT AND LIABILITY STATEMENT

Artwork:

1. Work must consist of one-of-a-kind or limited production items.
2. All art must be ready for display on delivery.
3. Medium of the work is art created with fire. Loosely interpreted. Includes glass, bronze, ceramics etc.
4. Wall and suspended art must have suitable means for hanging. Free standing art must be stable.
5. Any non-food-safe glazes must be disclosed to the gallery.
6. All art must remain at the Fire Gallery for a minimum of one (1) month.

Artist:

1. Agrees to consign artwork to the Fire Gallery free of charge.
2. Agrees to hand-deliver artwork to the Fire Gallery if no other arrangements have been made.

3. Shall supply the Fire Gallery with an artist's biography and high-resolution photos of representative work for promotional purposes, using the Fire Gallery contact information.
4. Shall supply the Fire Gallery an inventory list when delivering work.
5. Shall pay the Fire Gallery 50% commission on any special orders generated by customers who were met through/because of the Fire Gallery. Violation of this clause will result in immediate termination of the artist's association with the Fire Gallery.
6. Agrees not to have their work represented simultaneously at another retail venue within a 5-mile radius of the Fire Gallery.

Gallery:

1. Agrees to display selected items of artist's work for a minimum of one (1) month, and retains the rights to final curatorial and installation decisions.
2. Agrees to provide general promotion of Gallery work through regular press releases, emails, mailings, website postings, etc., crediting the individual artist whenever possible.
3. Reserves the right to accept or reject any individual piece of artwork at its sole discretion.
4. Agrees to pay all applicable sales tax generated by sales.
5. Agrees to pay artist on a timely basis.

Sales:

All artwork for sale is subject to a 50% commission and should be priced accordingly (retail price). If a piece is sold, Gallery will be responsible for delivery to buyer and a check for 50% of the sale will be written to the artist in the month following the date of sale.

Liability:

Gallery will take reasonable precautions to protect artwork. All artwork is insured from drop off dates through pick up dates, and not extending beyond that period. Gallery will not be responsible for any damage as a result of poor construction or design.

Promotional Materials: All artwork may be photographed and/or reproduced for educational and promotional purposes.
